

RESOLUTION 2015-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN DOMESTIC WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA TO ADOPT BACKFLOW PREVENTION CONTROL PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 49-353(A)(2)(1) requires protection of the potable water system from contamination due to backflow, backsiphonage or cross connection of contaminants through the water service connection;

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality requires an active program of cross-connection control which will prevent the contamination of all potable water supply systems;

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Domestic Water Improvement District is required by law to protect its water system from contamination caused by backflow through unprotected cross-connections;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Domestic Water Improvement District adopted and approved a backflow prevention control program on September 23, 1993;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN DOMESTIC WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA as follows:

The attached document entitled METROPOLITAN DOMESTIC WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT - BACKFLOW PREVENTION CONTROL PROGRAM is to be adhered to by District customers to protect the District's water system from contamination caused by backflow through unprotected cross-connection.
