Qualifications and Experience:

Under the general direction of the Utility Supervisor, this position assists monitors and leads the work activities of field staff as well as planning, organization, and implementation of assigned tasks.

Knowledge, skills, and abilities include:

- Knowledge of water distribution, water metering systems maintenance, repair and installation methods, materials, and equipment.
- Knowledge of the operation of distribution system assets and components.
- Knowledge of equipment used in the maintenance, repair, and installation of water systems.
- Knowledge of pump and motor operating curves.
- Knowledge of ground water well construction and operations.
- Skilled in establishing and maintaining effective working relationships.
- Skilled in assessing and prioritizing multiple tasks, projects, and demands.
- Ability to read/understand maps and plans relating to water systems.
- Ability to operate current and commonly used information technology devices.

Requirements:

- A high school diploma or equivalent; three (3) years experience in operating and maintaining public water utility assets; OR an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Valid Arizona Driver's License is required.
- Must obtain and maintain an Arizona Grade II Operators Certification in water distribution within one (1) year of employment.
