



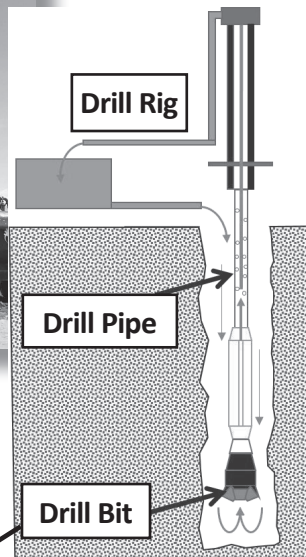
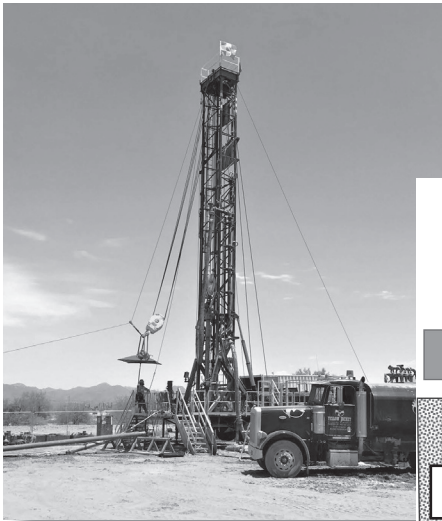

## Northwest Recharge, Recovery and Delivery System (NWRDRS) RECOVERY WELL DRILLING

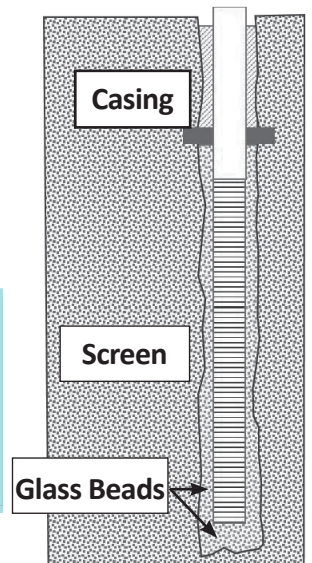
All the water that is delivered to your home comes from underground aquifers. The District just finished drilling three new production wells that will recharge renewable Central Arizona Project (CAP) water supplies instead of groundwater as part of the NWRDRS project. Here are some of the many steps that go into the drilling and completion of a production well.

**1.** The drilling rig bores a hole to the depth of the well. The casing and screen are then installed in the borehole.



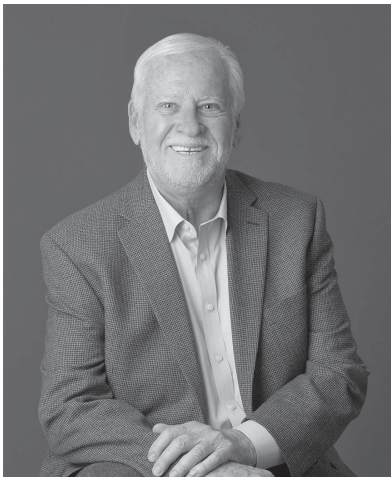
**2.** The stainless steel screen is surrounded by glass beads to filter out silt and particles.

**3.** After the well is constructed, a pump is installed to deliver water to your home or to other facilities for blending.

Along with our current production wells, these new wells will be used to continue providing safe, reliable water to our customers. 💧

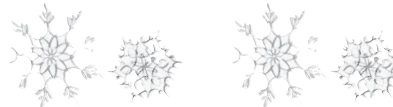
